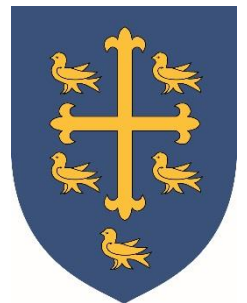

History of our school

- Our school was founded in 1874 by Sister Genevieve Dupuis on the grounds of St. Paul's Convent
- The original infant building was opened in 1895 on Raddlebarn Road
- Our current school building stands on convent land and was built in two stages 1969 and 2011, when we became united on one site in 2012.

Our School Meals- freshly prepared on site



- The Government currently subsidise the payments for all infant children Universal Free School Meals (UFSM). If you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals we do ask you to please complete a form. This could attract extra funding for school.
- Children who opt to bring sandwiches do have the option to have Pizza Thursday and Roast Wednesdays (KS2 children only)
- All of our school dinners are healthy and nutritious, with milk, salad and fruit available daily. Dinners cost £2.40 per day.
- Our menu is available on our website for parents to see what their child has eaten that day



Breakfast & After School Provision

Breakfast Club

- Our breakfast club is managed and staffed by members of our school staff
- There is a variety of food items for the children to choose from
- Breakfast club opens at 7:30a.m.
- The children are supervised until the beginning of the school day
- The club currently costs **£45.00** per half term per family; **£30.00** for a single child.

- Our After School Provision is provided by GSA Coaching Ltd. The coaching staff provide multi sport activities
- The club is held here at school from 3:30-5:30 p.m.

- ❖ Speaking and Listening

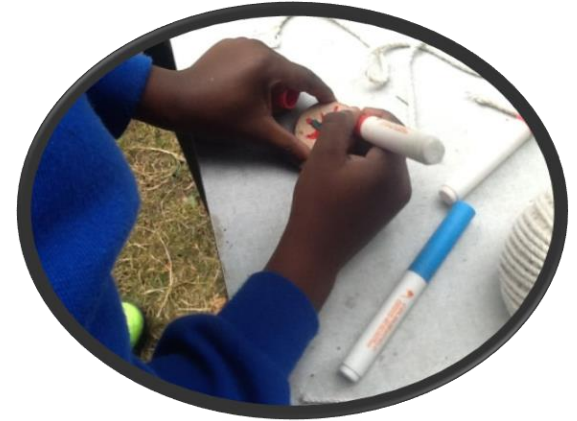

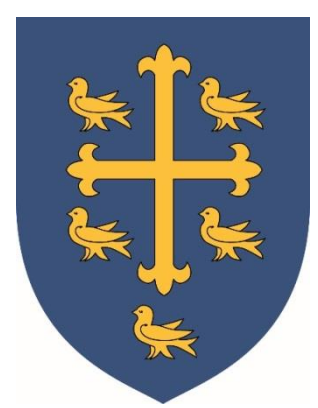

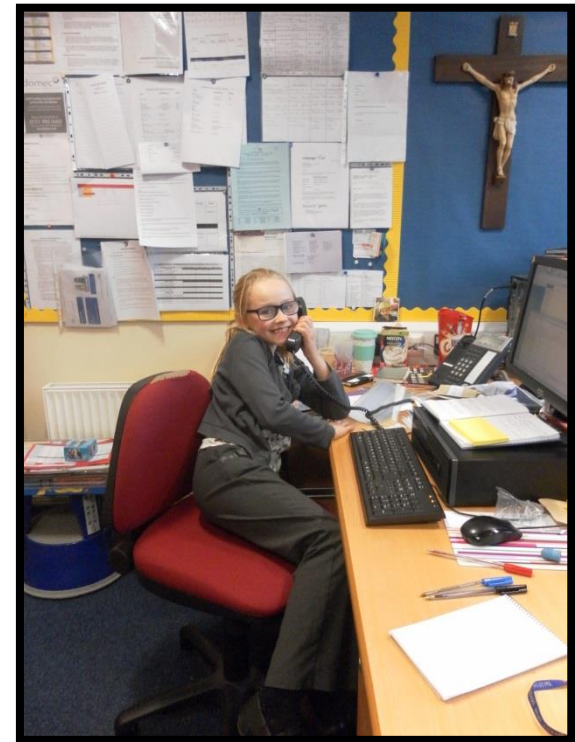
The adventures of our school bears ...

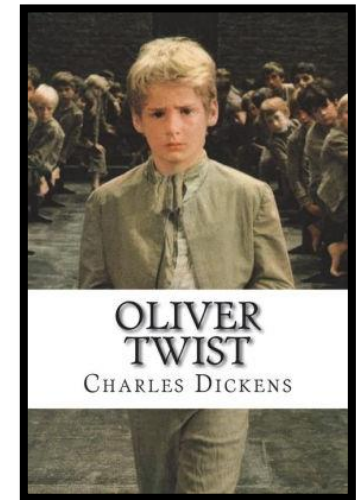
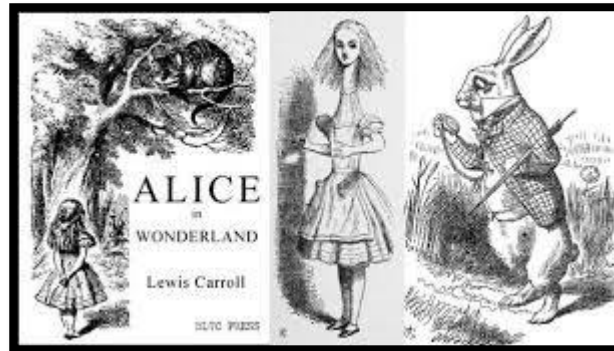
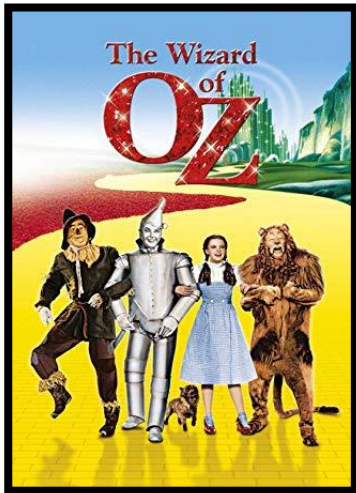
