CST Home Learning Activities



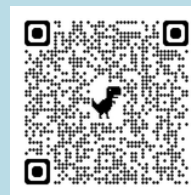
This half term as a school we are focusing on being Stewards of God's Creation

Watch the creation story together and discuss the events.

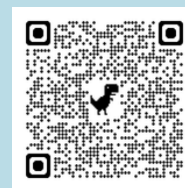


Try to walk, cycle or scoot to school. Log how many times a week you don't use a car when you could have.

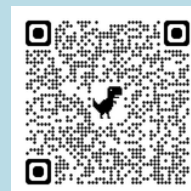


Plant something in your garden that adds to the beauty of God creation.
