Here are some optional activities you can complete at home.

Scripture Wall Art

Choose a Bible verse about family or community. Write it out and decorate it to display somewhere at home.

Community Heroes Poster

Create a poster about people who help your community (e.g. priest, nurse, teacher). Include how we can pray for and support them.

Find out about some different types of community.



Prayer for My Family

Write a short prayer thanking God for your family and asking Him to bless them.

Acts of Love Journal

Keep a journal for a week of small acts of love and kindness you show to family or community members. Reflect on how these actions made a difference.

Research & Reflect

Research a Catholic charity that supports families or communities (e.g. CAFOD, Caritas). Write a summary of their work and how it connects to Jesus’ teaching

Harvest festival- coming together as a community.



Family Tree Draw or create a simple family tree.

Label each person and write one thing you love about them..

.Community Walk

Go for a walk with a parent or guardian. Look for examples of community life (e.g. church, playground, shops). Draw or list what you see and how these places help people.
