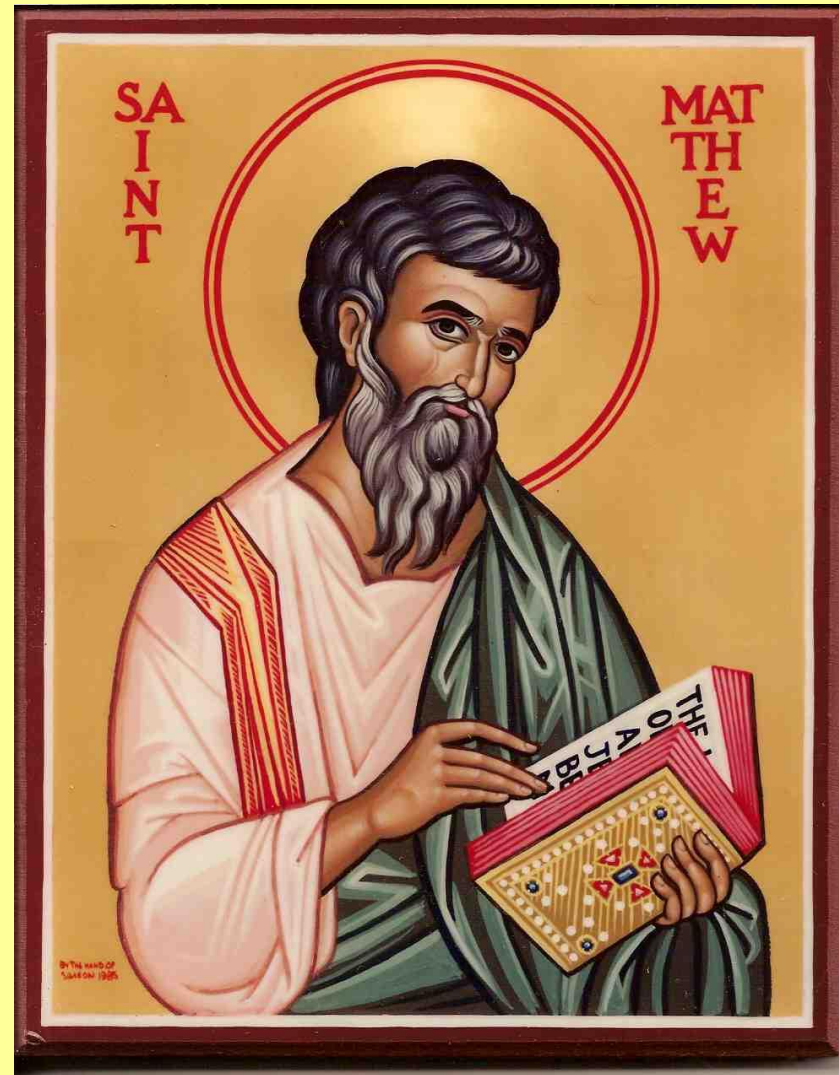


# Mass of St. Matthew
